Dr. Eleonora De Martin graduated from the Medical School at Padova University, Italy, in 2006. She was a visiting student at The Center for Liver Disease and Transplantation, Columbia University College of Physician and Surgeons, New York Presbyterian (Mentor Prof R.S. Brown Jr) in 2006. She obtained her specialization in Gastroenterology and Digestive Endoscopy at Padova University in 2011. During this training period she developed a particular interest in liver transplantation field and trained at the Multivisceral Transplant Unit, Padova, Italy (Mentor Prof. P. Burra). She completed her training at the Centre Hépatobiliaire, Hopital Paul Brousse, Villejuif, France (Mentor Prof. D. Samuel). She obtained the Diploma in Transplant Medicine of the European Board of Transplant Medicine in 2013. She received her PhD at Padova University in 2015. She was appointed chief resident at Centre-Hépatobiliaire, between 2014-2017. Currently she is senior physician at Centre-Hépatobiliaire. She is member of EASL (European Association for Study of the Liver) and ILTS (International Liver Transplantation Society). She is Member of the ILTS Vanguard Committee since 2018. Her fields of interest are liver transplantation, autoimmune hepatitis in particular severe acute forms and more recently hepatic toxicity of immunotherapy for metastatic cancer. She has been an active participant in national and international congresses (ILTS, EASL, ESOT, AASLD, AISF, AFEF) with oral and poster presentations. She was awarded the Young Investigator Award of ILTS, ELITA & LICAGE in 2017. In 2018 she has received a national grant for a multicenter French study on acute severe autoimmune hepatitis (PHRC-N: Pro-SURFASA). She has several publications in peer-reviewed journals. She is reviewer for indexed journals (Transplant International, Transplantation, American Journal of Transplantation, Clinical and Research in Hepatology and Gastroenterology).
