Dr. Felipe Alconchel Gago graduated from the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Córdoba (Spain) in 2016. While there, for three years he trained as an intern in hepatobiliopancreatic surgery and transplantation at the Reina Sofia University Hospital under the mentoring of J. Briceño, R. Ciria and P. López-Cillero.

He stayed at Institute of Liver Studies-King's College Hospital (London, UK) and at the Centre Hepato-Biliaire-Paul Brousse (Paris, France) for 3 months in each institution.

In May 2020 he completed his PhD studies about donation after circulatory death (DCD) in liver transplantation, under the direction of P. Ramirez and P.A. Cascales-Campos.

He actively participated in several meetings and congresses in the field of liver transplantation with oral and posters presentations (ILTS, TTS, ESOT, IHPBA, SETH, SET). He is the author or co-author of around twenty publications in peer-reviewed journals.

At present, he is carrying out his specialisation in Surgery at the Virgen de la Arrixaca University Hospital (Murcia, Spain) and is a researcher-in-training at the Biomedical Research Institute of Murcia (IMIB-Arrixaca).
