Outreach – our goal is to be a truly global reference point and we are determined to grow our membership throughout the world and address regional audiences. Our ILTS REAL program is continuing to make an enormous contribution (see page 7 for more information) to regional outreach. We have participated in the inaugural Egyptian Liver Transplantation Society (ELTS) international Congress in Cairo and Asian Transplantation Week in Seoul. I have been trying to connect with many liver transplant colleagues around the world. I visited Sudan and Oman where we helped set-up and mentor liver transplant programs. I have participated in various academic events on liver transplantation including at the Transplant Colloquium, Singapore, Pakistan Society for The Study of Liver Diseases and have plans to visit many more regions to promote the cause of ILTS in 2023.

Registries – The ILTS Registry is up-and-running, starting with LDLTregistry.org, which is a multidisciplinary collaborative of international physicians to study the outcomes of Living Donor Liver Transplantation (LDLT) meant to improve the practice of LDLT by sharing of research and innovation. 2022 marks the incorporation of ILTS as a non-profit society and we are celebrating the 30th anniversary of this milestone with a program culminating with the ILTS Congress in Rotterdam.






ISTANBUL, TURKEY AND ONLINE!

2022 ILTS VIRTUAL CONSENSUS CONFERENCE





"ERAS4OLT.ORG" ORGANIZED JOINTLY BY ILTS, THE ROYAL FREE HOSPITAL & UNIVERSITY COLLEGE LONDON

We held our highly successful virtual ILTS Consensus Conference on Enhanced Recovery after Surgery for Liver Transplantation at the end of January. Topics included preoperative evaluation in the setting of NASH, cirrhotic cardiomyopathy, cyto-absorption as a bridge to transplantation, and the critical care treatment

of postoperative complications. Over two jam-packed days, 32 expert panels covered the entire perioperative journey in deceased and live donor liver transplantation, presenting recommendations based on a rigorous systematic review of the literature following the Danish Model of consensus. Each presentation was followed by a discussion involving the international liver transplant community and a lay jury to yield a comprehensive, evidence-based ERAS program for liver transplantation.

This year, the Perioperative Care in Liver Transplantation meeting returned as a hybrid meeting co-hosted by ILTS and the liver team at the Ochsner Medical Center. The meeting was a superb learning event for the in-person participants in New Orleans as well as for those watching the webcast live online, designed to bring the latest advances in perioperative medicine to anesthesiologists, critical care physicians, nurses and allied specialists in the Americas and around the world.


